

**CONDITIONS FOR THE DISPLAY AND SALE OF GOODS FROM STREET STALLS BY
NON-COMMERCIAL ORGANISATIONS FOR FUND RAISING ACTIVITIES**

1. The particular day or days of the street stall use together with the sited or location must be approved by Council in writing.
2. The hours of sale are restricted to the period 9.00 a.m. to 5.00 p.m.
3. Food displayed for sale in the same state as consumed (e.g. cakes, scones, etc) must be pre-wrapped at the place of manufacture, in cellophane, plastic or approved paper to the satisfaction of the Environmental Health Officer and must remain so wrapped until sold.
4. No meats, including poultry and fish, either raw, cooked or frozen are to be displayed or sold.
5. The sale of milk or cream is prohibited.
6. All articles of secondhand clothing are to be thoroughly cleaned before being offered for sale and in the event of foodstuffs and secondhand clothing being available at the same sale, they must be on entirely separate tables and handled by different persons.
7. Uncooked foods such as fruit and vegetables shall also be displayed on tables separate from other goods.
8. The stalls, premises and/or surrounds must be maintained in a clean and tidy condition and the accumulation of any rubbish or refuse removed at the conclusion of the sale.
9. The stalls, premises and/or surrounds must be open to inspection by the Environmental Health Officer at all times during the hours of display and sale of goods.
10. All verbal and written instructions relating to the handling, display and sale of food which may be given by the Environmental Health Officer are to be complied with promptly.
