The following resolution was passed at the meeting of the Strategy and Community Committee on 18 June 2009.

**Parker/Weld**

**(a) That it be recommended to the Council:**

- (i) That Chapter 25 - Parking and Traffic Control of General Bylaw 1998, with amendments as shown by ~~double-strikethrough~~ for deletions and double underlining for additions, as set out in Appendix 2 to the agenda report with an amendment to 8.3 j) to read as follows: park a self-contained vehicle overnight for more than two nights in any one calendar month in any single location,**

18 and 19 June 2009

provided that the location shall not be within 500 metres of a commercial camping ground, be confirmed.

- (ii) That the parking restrictions in the Warkworth and Orewa town centres as set out in Maps: RDC 20314 Sheets 1 and 2 (17 June 2009) in Appendix 2 to the agenda report be confirmed.
- (iii) That Chapter 1 - Bylaw Administration be amended by the deletion of the definitions of 'park' and 'parking place' in section 2.1.
- (iv) That those parts of Chapter 8 - Public Places and Chapter 9 - Road Traffic and Numbering of Premises of General Bylaw 1998, shown as ~~struck through~~ in Appendix 3 to this Agenda report, be revoked.
- (v) That Chapter 9 - Road and Traffic Control and Numbering of Premises of General Bylaw 1998 be renamed as Chapter 9 - Road Crossings and Numbering of Premises.
- (vi) That it be confirmed that an effective car parking enforcement regime will be maintained and monitored during business hours in town centres on the Hibiscus Coast and in Warkworth.
